

72. SAFETY OFFICERS

Education

Required: Safety Certification from any internationally recognized body (i.e. NEBOSH, IOSH, NSC, BCSP etc...) OR a certification as Safety Professional from an Internationally recognized body.

Preferred: Diploma in Engineering or any related discipline with Safety Certification.

Experience

Required: Minimum 3 years of experience in the O&G Industry, out of which 1 years in safety field.

Preferred: Experience in Petrochemicals Industry in Safety field.

Languages

Required: English- proficient

Preferred: Arabic- working knowledge

Safety and Risk

- **Oversight the contractor safety performance by providing on site supervision.**
- **Assist in the planning and safe execution of work at the plant site to ensure the maintenance of a safe work environment by all contractors.**
- **Participate in Hazard Analysis and safety reviews and ensure that the safe execution is followed in the field accordingly.**
- **Participate in field audits and performance evaluations.**
- **Provide the assistance to contractors to follow the compliance requirements as per international safety standards such as OSHA, QPDG.**

Participate and/or support safety related incident investigations, participate in Root-cause Analysis, determine corrective actions and communicate lesson learned reports.

Training & Awareness

- **Assist in developing the training modules for the Occupation Safety standards and procedures for contractors.**

Assist in occupational safety training programs for contractors to ensure they are delivered in an optimum manner.

Inspection

- **Participate in inspection and proper maintenance of all contractor safety equipment and vehicles on site, to guarantee they meet all the necessary standards.**
- **Participate in annual performance verification audits for contractors.**

Emergency response and Incident Investigation

Participate in response to emergencies as required by the Emergency Response Plan, to assist in Incident Command to the site of the emergency.

Policies, Systems, Processes and Procedures

- Contribute to the identification of opportunities for the continuous improvement of systems, processes and practices in order to increase productivity and operational efficiency.

Participate in HSE Policy audits, such as PTW audits, L T & T audits, Annual Compliance verification audits.

Quality, Health, Security, Safety and Environment

Ensure compliance with regulatory requirements and relevant quality, health, safety, security and environmental procedures and controls across the contractors to guarantee contractor safety and delivery of high quality products/services.

Reporting

- Ensure that any incident / injury / illness on site is reported to COMPANY on timely manner.

Participate / support in developing, maintaining and recordkeeping safety performance indicators, including investigations, corrective actions, inspections, and hours worked metrics.
